**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has held meeting with Myanmar as reported in the Times of India dated December 25, 2006;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has asked Myanmar to crack down terror camps in their territory;
- (c) if so, the details of other issues discussed and the points raised by India during the said meeting; and
- (d) the reaction of Myanmar thereon?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGUPATHY)

(a) to (d) : On the invitation of Union Home Minister, Major Gen. Maungoo, Minister for Home Affairs, Govt. of Union of Myanmar accompanied by a four member delegation met Union Home Minister on the 21st December 2006. At this meeting, various issues of mutual concern including those related to security, drug trafficking and effective border management were discussed. The Myanmar delegation inter alia requested assistance in the field of training and capacity building of officers of Myanmar Police Force and assistance for setting up Multi Media Laboratory for language training and for DNA Finger Printing Laboratory. The visit of Myanmar Home Minister to India has provided a renewed impetus for widening and deepening of the India-Myanmar relations.
