EQUIPMENTS IN GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of health investigation facilities in various government hospitals located in Delhi;
- (b) the amount spent by the Government in procuring/ repairing new diagnostic equipments in various hospitals from 1 st January, 2006 till date;
- (c) the details of such diagnostic machines/ equipments which are out of order till date; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to restore the faith of the patients in the Government Hospitals for treatment?

(a) to (d): In so far as Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. RML Hospital and LHMC & Associated Hospitals are concerned, well equipped investigation facilities are available.

The amount spent for procurement/repair of diagnostic/investigation equipments from January, 2006 to till date is as under:-

1. Safdarjung Hospital Rs.272.64 lakh
2. Dr. RML Hospital Rs.494.34 lakh
3. LHMC & Associated Hospitals Rs.223.78 lakh
