(a) & (b) According to the information furnished by the University Grants Commission (UGC), there is no proposal to set up a committee to study the prevailing fee structure in the Private Deemed Universities and recommend a uniform admission policy. However, the UGC guidelines for Deemed to be Universities has a provision that admission procedure and fee fixation for students shall be in accordance with the norms / rules prescribed by the UGC.
