Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any fresh proposals to set up some Central Institute of Technology in the country particularly Assam;
- (b) if so, the details thereof location-wise;
- (c) the amount allocated for the same purpose; and
- (d) the time by which it is likely to be set up?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M.A.A. FATMI)

(a) and (b): There is no fresh proposal of Setting up of a Central Institute of Technology in Assam or other parts of the country. However, under Memorandum of Settlement (MoS) signed between Central Government, Government of Assam & Bodoland Liberation Tigers (BLT), a Central Institute of Technology

(CIT) in Kokrajhar, Assam has already been approved by the Government.

(c) The total project cost of CIT, Kokrajhar is Rs. 3365.00 lakh comprising of Rs. 715.00 lakh Recurring and Rs. 2650.00 lakh for Non-recurring expenditure. The Budget allocated for 2006-07 is Rs. 500.00 lakh.

(d) The CIT, Kokrajhar shall be set up during 2006-07 itself.
