Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether construction of six lanning of Delhi-Meerut Highway has been approved ;
- (b) if so, the details of the project;
- (c) whether six lanning of Meerut-Haridwar-Dehradun highway has not been approved ;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the action taken by the Government to expedite the approval ?

Answer

- (a) and (b) Six lanning of Delhi-Meerut section of National Highway (NH) has been approved. Preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) is in progress at present.
- (c),(d) and (e) Six lanning of Meerut-Haridwar-Dehradun section of NH is not envisaged at this stage. Presently, four lanning of Meerut-Muzaffarnagar section of NH has been awarded and four laning is proposed to be continued in Muzaffarnagar-Haridwar-Dehradun section of NH under National Highway Development Project (NHDP) Phase-III.
