CONSTRUCTION OF BYE-PASSES ON NH-24

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of bye-passes to be constructed on National Highway No.24 alongwith the details thereof ;
- (b) whether the proposal to construct bye-pass through Bareilly is pending for consideration; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the proposal is likely to be cleared and construction work started?

Answer

(a), (b) and (c) Presently there is no fresh proposal for constructing a bypass in Delhi-Moradabad section of NH-24. Four laning of Lucknow-Sitapur section of NH-24 has been taken up in NHDP Phase-IIIA which also does not provide for construction of any bypass. For Moradabad-Bareilly and Bareilly-Sitapur sections of NH-24, preparation of project design has been taken up by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) under NHDP Phase-IIIB. Since land acquisition for Bareilly bypass had already been taken up and a draft Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the bypass had also been prepared in the Ministry, NHAI has been requested to consider this draft DPR while finalizing the said project design.
