STERILIZATION OPERATIONS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) The number of sterilization operations and the cases of deaths due to sterilization that occurred during the each of the last three years and till date, state wise and year wise.
- (b) whether such unsuccessful caseS of sterilization have been reported wherein both husband and wife have also been sterilized.
- (c) If so, the state wise number thereof and the provision regarding payment of compensation to them and the conditions under which compensation have been denied to them

Answer

THE MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

- (a) Information for each of the last 3 years is placed at Annexure.
- (b)&(c) During the last 3 years no such case has been reported by any of the states or U.T.However, one such case had been reported in 1998 from Jash Pur, M.P.(now in Chattisgarh). Compensation was denied to Smt Urmila Tiwari and Sh. Ranganath Tiwari by govt. of M.P. on the ground that there are chances of failure of 0.5% in female sterilization and 0.1% in male sterilization. Prior to the introduction of the National Family Planning Insurance scheme in November 2005, there was no provision for compensation for failure of sterilization operation. Under the present Family Planning Insurance scheme Rs. 25,000 is payable
- (once) for failure of sterilization operation.
