- (b) the allocation made for this project; and
- (c) the amount spent so far?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

(a): Peddapalli–Karimnagar (35.52 Kms) section has been completed and commissioned. Karimnagar–Jagityal (48 Kms) section is targeted for completion during 2006–07. Work of Jagityal–Nizamabad (94.35 Kms) section has also been taken up. The detailed estimate has been sanctioned and land acquisition is under process.

(b) & (c): An expenditure of Rs.136.64 crore has been incurred up to 31.03.2006. An outlay of Rs. 40 crore has been provided during 2006–07. An outlay of Rs. 35 crore has been proposed in the Budget 2007–08.
