- (d) the names of ex-officio officers in this Commission at present?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI GHULAM NABIAZAD)

(a) and (b) The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has reported that the Draft Master Plan for Delhi-2021 has been formulated after wide ranging consultations with experts from the related fields, local bodies, professional organizations, etc. Central Government has permitted the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to notify the draft Master Plan for Delhi-2021 for inviting objections and suggestions from individuals, government bodies/ NGOs and all concerned.

(c) The Delhi Urban Art Commission (DUAC) was constituted on 1 st May, 1974 under the Delhi Urban Commission's Act, 1973 with a view to preserving, developing and maintaining the aesthetic quality of urban and environmental design within Delhi.

(d) The names of ex-officio persons in the Commission at present are as under:-
