(a)&(b): The National Mission for Manuscripts, under Ministry of Culture, had submitted the nomination of the Rig Veda Manuscripts from Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute, Pune, for inclusion in the UNESCO's "Memory of the World" Register and 30 of these manuscripts have been included in the Register, 2007. The oldest of these 30 manuscripts dates back to 1464 AD. The programme of the Memory of the World has been started by UNESCO to honour significant landmarks in the documentary heritage and record them in this Register as world's inheritance.
