(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): The Government of Maharashtra has prepared a master plan for introduction of Metro Rail System in Mumbai in 9 corridors to be implemented in 3 Phases. The details of 9 corridors are as under:-

S.No. Corridor Length in Kms.

1. Versova-Andheri-Ghatkopar 11.07
2. Charkop-Bandra-Mankhurd 31.8
3. Colaba-Mahim-Bandra 19.95
4. Charkop-Dahisar 7.5
5. Ghatkopar-Mulund 12.4
6. B.K.C. to Kanjur Marg via Airport 19.5
- 7 Andheri (East)-Dahisar (East) 18
8. Hutatma Chowk-Ghatkopar 21.8
9. Sewri-Prabhadevi 3.5
