**Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the Anti-India propaganda by the Pakistan High Commissions situated in other countries and protection being provided to the terrorists;
- (b) if so, the number of such cases brought to the notice of the Government during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has taken up the issue with the concerned countries; and
- (d) if so the details thereof and the reaction of the concerned countries thereto?

**Answer**

(a)&(b) Yes. Government are aware of Pakistan High Commissions spreading anti-India propaganda. Instances of these Missions facilitating terrorists have also come to notice.

(c)&(d) The issue of involvement of Pakistan High Commissions in anti-India activities has been taken up with the governments concerned.
