- (a) The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been implementing following schemes for scheduled tribes through non-governmental organisations across the country including State of Karnataka, namely
- (i) Grants-in-aid to Voluntary Organisations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes
 - (ii) Educational Complex in Low Literacy Pockets for development of womens' literacy in tribal areas
 - (iii) Vocational Training Centre in Tribal Areas
 - (iv) Scheme of Coaching and Allied and
 - (v) Development of Primitive Tribal Groups through Non-Governmental Organisations in Karnataka.
