**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposals from the State Government of Orissa regarding development of Daringbari as a tourist spot during 2005-06 and 2006-07;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard; and
- (c) the financial assistance provided for development of Daringbari so far?

**Answer**

(a), (b) & (c): During 2006-07 one project proposal for development of Daringbari as a tourist spot has been received from Government of Orissa for an amount of Rs.123.50 lakh. The project proposal was examined for providing Central Financial Assistance as per guidelines and found incomplete as details of cost estimates (components wise), undertaking etc. were not available. The Government of Orissa has been requested for the same but the documents have not been submitted so far.
