PERFORMANCE OF NGOS IN RAJASTHAN

- (a) the number of NGOs working in Rajasthan under Rural Development;
- (b) the details of projects being undertaken by them during the last three years;
- (c) the fund sanctioned/disbursed to them during the period;
- (d) whether the Government is satisfied with their performance;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons thereof ?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SURYAKANTA PATIL)

(a) to (c) The Council for Advancement of People`s Action and Rural Technology (CAPART), which is an autonomous body under the aegis of the Ministry of Rural Development has assisted 356 Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) in Rajasthan. CAPART has sanctioned 99 projects to 79 NGOs in Rajasthan during the last three years. A statement showing the scheme-wise amount sanctioned and released to them during the said period is at Annexure-I.

(d) to (f) Out of 99 projects sanctioned, 38 projects have been completed satisfactorily. The remaining projects are at various stages of implementation.
