RAIL LINK BETWEEN BEENA VIA SIRONJ

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is rail link between Beawar to Beena via Sironj;
- (b) whether any proposal from the State Government has been received in this regard;
- (c) the action being taken by the Union Government in this regard; and
- (d) the time by which railway facility is likely to be provided between Beawar and Beena via Sironj ?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

(a): No, Sir.

(b) to (d): No, Sir. However, a survey for new broad gauge line from Biyawara Rajgarh-Sironj-Bina was conducted in 1999. As per the survey report, cost of construction of this 147 km long line has been assessed as Rs.224.75 crore with a negative rate of return. In view of acute constraint of resources and heavy throwforward of ongoing projects, it has not been feasible to consider the project.
