VACANT POSTS IN CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that a large number of teachers posts are lying vacant in central universities and colleges;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to fill up these vacancies; and
- (c) the time by which these posts are likely to be filled up?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M.A.A.FATMI)

(a) to (c): The power to make appointment to the teaching posts in a Central University vests in its Executive Council, which acts on the recommendations of Selection Committees constituted in terms of the relevant statutory provisions. Since this is a continuous process, it would not be possible to indicate any time frame by which the vacant posts of teachers will be filled in. While the Government's role is limited to providing the Visitor's nominees on the Selection Committees, the Govt., through the UGC, keeps reminding the Central Universities to fill the vacant posts.
