Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Rs. 24 crore project to set up a multi-speciality state of the art trauma center at Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital in Delhi has not come up as yet, though the project was originally conceived way back in 1999 and the foundation stone was laid in 2001;
- (b) if so, the status of the project as on date; and
- (c) the time by which the project is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c) The construction of the five-storied multi-speciality trauma care centre building is completed up to 2nd floor. As per the revised schedule given by CPWD, the construction of the Trauma Centre is schedule to be completed by 31st March, 2005.
