CONSTRUCTION OF OVER-BRIDGES TO CONNECT CENTRAL AVENUE WITH WESTERN

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Central Railway proposes to construct a new Overbridge to connect the Central avenue with Western end of Nagpur Railway Station;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the progress made in this regard, till date ?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS ( SHRI R. VELU)

(a) to (c): No, Sir. Central Railway has no such proposal. However, Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation (MSRDC) has proposed construction of a new 6 lane cable stayed bridge on Build, Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis across Nagpur Station Yard connecting eastern part (Central Avenue) with west side of Nagpur Station. General Arrangement Drawing for this work has already been approved by Railways.
