TESTING OF NAG MISSILE

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the anti-tank missile Nag was tested recently;
- (b) if so, whether it is successful to meet all the requirement;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by when the missile is likely to be provided to the Army?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE)

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) & (c): Two flight tests undertaken on 10.6.2004 and 3.7.2004 were successful and met all the mission objectives set for it. During first flight missile was guided to target in a top attack mode using Imaging Infra Red (IIR) seeker and a direct hit to target was achieved and during the second flight the warhead detonation sequence was successfully evaluated.

(d) User Trials are planned by end 2004 after that missile system will enter the production phase.
