Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes (SCs/STs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) employees in the public sector banks, bank-wise;
- (b) whether there is any backlog of vacancies for SCs/STs and OBCs in the public sector banks;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, bank-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken or being taken to clear the backlog?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL)

(a): Bank-wise details of number of SCs, STs & OBCs employees working in the Public Sector Banks/FIs as on 31.12.2005(latest available) is given in the Annexure.

(b), (c) & (d):The Government instructions regarding Special Recruitment Drive to fill up the backlog vacancies reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe were forwarded to all the Public Sector Bauiks, Financial Institutions and Insurance Companies with the direction to fill up the backlog reserved vacancies as per the scheduled given by the Department of Personnel & Training (DOP&T). The progress made by the Banks/FIs and Insurance Companies had been reviewed in several meetings held with the General Managers of Banks/FIs and the matter has been pursued with them constantly. Out of 3558 identified reserved vacancies, 3381 vacancies have been filled up by 30.11.2006. The filling up of backlog vacancies for OBCs is not monitored.
