(a)&(b) The State Government of Karnataka has reported that the State has sought access to cheaper sources of funds to finance its on going irrigation projects. The Union Government has been providing Central Loan Assistance (CLA) under Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme(AlBP) to eight major/medium irrigation projects of Karnataka since inception of the programme in 1996-97. The CLA under AlBP is released depending upon the ceiling fixed by the Planning Commission. During the current year Planning Commission has fixed CLA ceiling of Rs.250.00 crore for Karnataka.
