- (a) the number of solar lanterns distributed in Bihar to the persons living below poverty line during the last three years:
- (b) whether the programme of distributing the solar lanterns has since been discontinued;
- (c) if so, the facts and reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the government is now formulating a new scheme in order to provide the same without hassles; and
- (e) if so, the modalities thereof?

(a) (b) & (c): Till the financial year 2001-02, the Ministry of Non-Conventional Energy Sources was implementing a programme all over the country including Bihar for the supply of solar lanterns at subsidized costs. However, the subsidy on solar lanterns was withdrawn from the financial year 2002-03 to avoid possible misuse of the scheme and to enable development of a free market for solar lanterns. The number of solar lanterns distributed in Bihar under the programme during the last three years are given below:

Year Number of Solar Lanterns Distributed

2001-02 2500 2002-03 5500 Spill over from the previous years allocations 2003-04 Nil

The scheme was open to all categories of users. No statistics for number of systems distributed to the persons living below poverty line is available.
