WITHDRAWAL OF BUMPER SUPER SAVER SCHEME

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Indian airlines has decided to withdraw the bumper Super Saver Scheme;
- (b) if so, the details and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the total number of tickets sold under the said scheme?

Answer

(a) and (b): The validity period of promotional fares is invariably dictated and determined with reference to market conditions. The Bumper Super Saver Scheme was introduced as a promotional scheme during the lean period and is being withdrawn after 31st March, 2005.

(c): Since the scheme is still continuing, this does not arise.
