- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of loss suffered in the said incident;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to give any compensation to the owners of the said trucks; and
- (e) if so, the details in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGUPATHY)

(a)to(c): No Sir. However, on January 11, 2005, during a 24 hour bandh call given by All Adivasi Students Association of Assam, five coal loaded trucks were put on fire by the bandh activists.

(d)&(e): The Central Government has no provision for payment of compensation in such type of incidents.
