PARKING PROBLEMS IN DELHI

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that public visiting markets, like Chandni Chowk, Fatehpuri, Sadar Bazar etc. are finding difficulty in parking their vehicles which are found closed or full;
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Government to provide parking facility to the public;
- (c) whether the roads in Delhi are of poor quality damaging small vehicles and causing avoidable accidents; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken by the Government to improve the existing road conditions and by when?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGUPATHY)

(a) & (b): Providing parking facilities for all the vehicles of visitors in the congested areas of the Old City like Chandni Chawk, Fatehpuri and Sadar Bazar is difficult due to lack of space and growing number of vehicles. However, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi has provided parking facilities at Gandhi Ground, Bagh Diwar, Radha Mohan Club, Gandhi Maidan, Lajpat Rai Market, Parade Ground, Church Mission Road and near Sadar Bazar.

(c) & (d): The roads in Delhi are generally of required specifications and necessary repairs are carried out as and when required to keep them in satisfactory condition.
