- (a) whether the NH-2 from Delhi to Agra is to be widened from 4 lane to 6 lane;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the time by which work on the stretch would commence and be completed; and
- (d) the projected cost of the project?

(a) to (d) Yes, Sir. Delhi to Agra section of National Highway No.2 in a length of 180 km is to be widened from 4 lane to 6 lane under National Highway Development Project (NHDP) Phase-V. Bids were invited with original due date as 24.12.2008. As no bids were received even after repeated extension of bid due date, it is proposed to re-invite bids after restructuring the project. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 2157 crore.
