Y-SHAPE BRIDGE IN RAIPUR

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) time schedule fixed by the Railways for completing the Y-shape bridge which is being built on Raipur level crossing in Durg District of Chhattisgarh;
- (b) whether the construction of the said bridge has not been completed so far despite elapsing of time schedule and the construction work is stand still at present;
- (c) if so, whether any action has been taken against the agencies involved in the Construction of the said bridge for delay of this project; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS(SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (d) The Y shape Road Over Bridge (ROB) sanctioned in the year 2006-07, is being constructed on deposit term basis. It is located at Km.867/7-8 in Durg Yard. Initially, the work got delayed on account of non-deposit of amount by the State Government. Shifting of level crossing goomty and cabin also took time. Presently, 100% of approach portion and 80% of bridge portion have been completed. 13 of 15 Spans of superstructure/girder have been completed. The work is in progress in the last two spans. The work is expected to be completed by March 2011.
