Answer

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The work of new line from Manoharabad-Kothapalli (148.90 km.) was included in the Budget 2006-07. Final Location Survey has been completed and detailed estimate prepared.
- (c) An amount of Rs. 43 lakh has been incurred on the project upto 31-03-2009 and an outlay of Rs. 2 crore has been provided for 2009-10.
- (d): The work will be completed in coming years as per availability of resources.
