- (b) if so, the details thereof and progress made so far in this regard?

(a) & (b): Amreli and Bhavnagar are already connected by railway line via Dhasa & Dhola. A survey for new line between Bhavnagar-Tarapur was completed during 2006-07 as per which cost of this 135 km long line was assessed as Rs. 411.27 crore. The proposal could not be considered due to its un-remunerative nature, heavy throw-forwarded of ongoing projects and constraint of resources.
