- (a) whether entrance exams for premier educational institutes viz. All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Indian Institute of Management (IIM) and Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) are based only on CBSE course whereas there are several State education boards which have courses different from CBSE;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether any initiatives have been taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to implement common curriculum all over the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons for not adopting inclusive education policy?
