- (c) whether the land has been acquired for the purpose, if so, the details thereof and the time by which the project is likely to be completed;
- (d) whether there are scope of reviewing the previous policy and bringing down the cost of renewable power; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the subsidy component to be paid to buyers of power from these projects?
