TWELFTH REPORT

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Monday, the 9th May, 2005.

2. The Committee recommend the allocation of time to the following items of business as shown against each:

(1)	The Right to Information Bill, 2004. <u>(Consideration and passing)</u>	4 hours
(2)	The University of Allahabad Bill, 2004, after it has been passed by Rajya Sabha. <u>(Consideration and passing)</u>	1 hour
(3)	The Private Security Agencies (Regulation) Bill, 2005, after it has been passed by Rajya Sabha. <u>(Consideration and passing)</u>	2 hours
(4)	The Credit Information Companies (Regulation) Bill, 2004, after it has been passed by Rajya Sabha. <u>(Consideration and passing)</u>	2 hours

(5)	The Weapons of Mass Destruction and their Delivery Systems (Prohibition of Unlawful Activities) Bill, 2005, after it has been passed by Rajya Sabha. <i>(Consideration and passing)</i>	2 hours
(6)	The Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council, Bill, 2004. <i>(Consideration and passing)</i>	2 hours
(1)	The Special Economic Zones, Bill, 2005. <i>(Consideration and passing)</i>	2 hours

3. The Committee also recommend that in order to make more time available for disposal of urgent items of Government and other business, if necessary, the House may sit upto 7 P.M., daily for the remainder of the Current Session.
