Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a shortage of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) distributors/ retailers in Jammu and Kashmir (J&K);
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the number of LPG distributors/ retailers in various States of the country along with dealer-consumer ratio, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to increase the number of LPG distributors/ retailers ensuring smooth delivery of LPG cylinders to the consumers?

Answer

(a) to (c): Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have reported that they are having adequate number of LPG distributors to meet the genuine requirement of LPG to the registered LPG customers with their distributors in the State of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K).

Moreover, the appointment of LPG distributorship is a continuous process. Locations for setting up LPG distributorships are identified based on available refill sale potential that can sustain economically viable operation of an LPG distributorship. The refill sale potential is based on several factors including population, population growth rate and economic prosperity in the area.

As on 01.06.2014, the details of LPG distributorships under various stages of selection process is as under :-
