Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide budgetary support to planned investment for Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) in the 12th Five Year Plan period to strengthen them;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, year -wise and PSE-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) The details of pending proposals from each CPSE in this regard and the time by which these proposals are likely to be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) to (d): In general, the Government has not proposed to provide Budgetary Support for planned investment on Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) in the 12th Five Year Plan. In fact, 12th Plan envisages the Central (CPSEs) to mobilize Rs.16, 22,898 crore as Internal & Extra Budgetary Resources (IEBR) for investment.

Details of Budgetary Support to CPSEs given by the Government after considering recommendations of their administrative ministries for the years 2012-13, 2013-14 and BE 2014-15 were given in "Statement 14" in Expenditure Budget Volume I of 2014-15 which was tabled in Parliament by the Finance Ministry on 10th July, 2014 as Budget document.
