(a) to (e)) The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways had constituted an expert committee in February 2012 to formulate 'National Ambulance Code' along with detailed specifications for various types of ambulances for the country. The Expert Committee has submitted a draft National Ambulance Code for approval of the Ministry. The Ministry has notified draft GSR 316(E) dated 23.04.2015, inviting comments/views from the public.
