(a) to (d) There are over 40 skill development schemes implemented by over 18 Central Ministries/Departments across various sectors which has the mandate to promote skilling of all the people in the Country. Most of these schemes have special provisions to promote the participation in skill development programmes by all socio-economic groups, including Anglo Indians.
