(a) & (b) Government of Jammu & Kashmir has recently submitted No Objection Certificate (NOC) for entrustment of Jammu-Akhnur-Naoshera-Rajauri-Punch section of National Highway No. 144A.

(c) to (e) There is no plan for four laning of this highway upto Uri in North Kashmir, as Uri is not connected with this National Highway. This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways, which is a continuous process through its implementing agencies. The development and maintenance of this National Highway depends on inter-se-priority and availability of funds.
