## Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) proposes an expansion plan to increase power generation capacity from 30,000 MW to 75,000 MW;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the new power projects proposed to be set up by NTPC in the country, Statewise;
- (d) whether NTPC has any plan to raise the revenue for the same; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR POWER, COAL AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY ( SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL )

(a) to (e): The present generation capacity of NTPC (including Joint Ventures and Subsidiaries) is 43,128 MW. Another 22,414 MW is already under execution. Further, NTPC has planned but not yet placed award for another 10,000 MW which will enable it to reach 75,000 MW approximately by the end of 13th Five Year Plan.

State-wise list of projects under construction is placed at Annex.

NTPC finances its capital expenditure in the ratio of 70:30 (Debt:Equity). The debt is raised from the market and equity is provided through internal accruals.
