Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to start hospitality courses in Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs);
- (b) whether the Government has also any proposal to modernise ITIs in the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR STEEL, MINIES AND LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

(a): Yes Madam, Hospitality sector courses are being run in the Government and Private ITIs under Craftsmen Training Scheme and in industries under Apprenticeship Training Scheme of Directorate General of Employment and Training.

(b) & (c): The Government has implemented following schemes for modernization of ITIs:

i) "Up-gradation of 1396 Government ITIs through PPP".

The scheme was operationalized throughout the country during the XI five year Plan (2007-2012) for the purpose of modernization/upgradation of existing Government ITIs. Under the scheme, a total of 1227 Govt. ITIs have been covered. The state-wise information is Annexed at "A".

i) "Vocational Training Improvement Project" (VTIP) under world Bank Assistance.

The scheme envisages upgradation of 400 ITIs in 34 State Governments/UTs. The state-wise information is Annexed at "B"
