- (c) & (d): As per the report based on the last three surveys on Employment-Unemployment conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) during July 2004 June 2005, July 2009 June 2010 and July 2011 June 2012, the State/UT wise Proportion (per 1000) of workers working in manufacturing sector, to total number of workers, as per usual status (ps+ss) is given in the statement at Annexure II.
