(a) to (c): Government of India provides financial assistance to State Governments under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) and Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) for setting up soil testing laboratories. At present there are 1206 Soil Testing Laboratories (1018 Static & 188 Mobile in the country. State-wise statement of soil testing laboratories is annexed.
