STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 63 FOR 27.11.2014 RAISED BY SHRI A. ANWHAR RAAJHAA, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT (LOK SABHA) REGARDING SETHUSAMUDRAM PROJECT

- (a): Consequent to the order of the Supreme Court of India, implementation of the Sethusamudram Ship Channel Project (SSCP) has been stopped since July, 2009.
- (b) to (d): Yes, Madam. Government of India is exploring the possibility of an alternate route for SSCP through Pamban Pass without affecting the Ram Sethu/Adam's Bridge. Rail India Technical and Economic Service (RITES) has carried out a pre-feasibility study and submitted the Report in November, 2014. Key findings of the Report are annexed.
