THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) to (c): No, Madam. This Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has not received any offer from World Bank under Global Infrastructure Facility Programme of World bank for building infrastructure. Ministry of Road Transport & Highways is responsible for development management and maintenance of National Highways in the country. World bank is providing assistance to this Ministry for the National Highways Interconnectivity Improvement Project (NHIIP) under which eleven projects in the state of Bihar, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Odisha and Karnataka have been taken up for improvement. Besides, World Bank is also providing loan assistance to National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) under the World Bank Technical Assistance Project namely Consultancy Services for Technical Assistance to Strengthen Assets Management Capacity of NHAI.
