Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of recognized Ayurveda colleges in the country along with the number of graduate and post-graduate seats therein, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up/recognize new Ayurveda colleges, particularly in the backward and tribal areas of the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise;
- (d) whether the Government has received any proposal in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government thereon during the last three years and the current year, State/UTwise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

(a): The number of recognized Ayurveda colleges in the country along with the number of graduate and post-graduate seats therein, State/UT-wise is given in Annexure-I.

(b) to (e): The State/UT-wise details of proposals received to recognize new Ayurveda colleges and the action taken by the Government thereon during the last three years and the current year, are given in Annexure-II.

The Government has approved setting up of

(i) All India Institute Ayurveda at Sarita Vihar, New Delhi to conduct Post-graduate and Ph.D. courses in Ayurveda and (ii) North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homeopathy at Shillong in Meghalaya to conduct Under-graduate course both in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy.

Under the revised scheme of National AYUSH Mission for Development of AYUSH Educational Institutions, grant-in-aid up to maximum limit of Rs.10.5 crore is admissible for setting up of new Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathy Educational Institutions in the States where it is not available in the Government Sector. So far, the Government has not received any proposal till date as per the revised Scheme of National AYUSH Mission.
