(a) whether the Government proposes to review the policy that bars a second airport within a 150km radius of an existing airport;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and

(c) the time by which the said policy is likely to be reviewed?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Dr. Mahesh Sharma)

(a): No, Madam. Although the Greenfield Airport Policy, 2008 does not allow a second airport within an aerial distance of 150 Km of an existing civilian airport, the Policy has a provision for exempting any such proposal by the Government of India after examination of the impact of the proposed airport on the existing airport.
