**Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the present gas extraction capacity from the Kakinada project;
- (b) whether the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited has reviewed the project very recently;
- (c) if so, the details and outcome thereof: and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for optimal utilisation of this project?

**Answer**

(a) to (d) The present gas handling capacity of Odalarevu Onshore Terminal is 2.75 MMSCMD and 9420 bbls oil per day (1500m<sup>3</sup>/day).

With the implementation of Integrated Development of Vashishtha & S1 fields, Onshore Capacity at Odalarevu will be augmented from existing about 2.75 MMSCMD to 8.75 MMSCMD i.e. additional processing trains for 6 MMSCMD.

ONGC management has reviewed Kakinada projects on 11th November, 2014. Details are given in Annexure.
