## MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE)(DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (c): Development and promotion of tourism is primarily undertaken by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, Ministry of Tourism (MoT) provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for tourism projects, which are identified in consultation with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations including Uttar Pradesh and funds released for the projects that are complete as per scheme guidelines, subject to availability of funds and utilization of funds released earlier. However, the State Government of Uttar Pradesh has prioritized one project namely; Tourism Development of Queen Hoe Memorial Complex and Signages in Korean language and SEL Shows in Ayodhya in the year 2014-15 for which Project Report has not been received by MOT.

Details of funds sanctioned to the State of Uttar Pradesh for the tourism projects in Ayodhya during 11th & 12th Plan period are given as under:
