SETTING UP OF TECHNICAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTES

**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has any scheme to set up any technical educational institutes in the country including Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/district-wise and the time by which these are likely to be set up; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a) & (b) Yes, Madam. Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh is one of the IIITs under the Scheme for setting up 20 New IIITs in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. IIIT Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh was approved on 27.1.2014. The details of the states approved by this ministry are at Annexure-I. Besides this scheme, the Government has announced establishment of IITs in 5 States, IIMs in 6 States and IIIT in one state this year. These are announced for- States of Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Goa, Jammu and Chhattisgarh for 5 new IITs; States of Bihar, Odisha, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh & Punjab for 6 new IIMs and State of Andhra Pradesh for one new IIIT.

This Ministry has initiated a scheme of setting up new polytechnics under which 41 Polytechnics are being set up in U.P. (Details are at Annexure- II). So far 6 polytechnics out of 41 polytechnics have been completed.

Government of India sets up Site Selection Committees with representatives of State Governments for these institutions. All proposals of State Governments are placed before these committees. Based on proposals and field visits, the Site Selection Committee has to make recommendations for approval of Central Government.
