Title: Regarding Business of the House and behaviour of some members.

MR. SPEAKER: Hon. Members, since morning the proceedings of the House are being disturbed. I appreciate the anxiety of the Members to raise the issue relating to problems being faced by the farmers in the country on the floor of the House. Keeping in view the importance of the matter, the Chair is also inclined to consider to allow a discussion on the subject in any manner including by way of an Adjournment Motion.

Unfortunately, some Members are neither willing to listen to the Chair nor permitting the House to debate the issue in an orderly manner. I strongly deprecate this tendency on the part of these Members. Under these circumstances, I am left with no option except to adjourn the House for the day.

However, I am still prepared to allow a discussion on the subject tomorrow in any manner on proper notices.

Now, the House stands adjourned to meet tomorrow, the 22nd November, 2000, at 11.00 a.m.
